A BEREAVEMENT SUPPORT GROUP PROGRAM FOR ADOLESCENTS AND TEENS

KALEIDOSCOPE™ is a four week program that explains death, dying, grief, bereavement and mourning to children ages 10-15 who have lost a loved one. The program is a combination of discussion and age oriented activities designed to assist each child in understanding and moving through their grief process.

Facilitating the program will be Amie J. Harris, LCSW, CT, and Maria A. Caruso, MS, CT, LPC of **LIVING WITH DIGNITY™**, a non-profit organization providing psycho-oncology and bereavement support services to individuals and families. Both facilitators are members of the Association of Death Education and Counseling (ADEC), and Ms. Harris is a certified grief therapist.
